### 1.2P. ELIGIBILITY

The **20th TERRES DU GATINAIS CROSS-COUNTRY RALLY** counts towards:

- The French Off-Road Rally Championship – Drivers and Co-Drivers
- The 4x4 Rally Trophy – Drivers and Co-Drivers
- The 2-Wheel Drive Rally Challenge – Drivers and Co-Drivers
- The SSV Rally Challenge – Drivers and Co-Drivers

### 1.3P. VÉRIFICATIONS

Entered crews may check on the website of **ASA LOIRET** [www.asa-loiret.com](http://www.asa-loiret.com) and rally web site [www.rallyegatinais.fr](http://www.rallyegatinais.fr) the confirmation of their entry and the schedule for administrative and technical scrutineering (convocation time at the Technical Checks Area, which **must be strictly respected**).

It is the responsibility of drivers **not listed** at the close of entries to contact the **technical organizer** at the telephone number indicated in **Article 1 – ORGANISATION**.

- The original copies of the licences, driving licence, and vehicle technical passport.
- A vehicle loan authorisation if the driver is not the owner of the vehicle.
- A copy of a bank statement or IBAN, as well as the designation of the prize money beneficiary.
- Quad or motorcycle registration documents

### **3.1P. ENTRY FORM – REGISTRATIONS**

#### **3.1.1.4P ENTRY**

Any person wishing to participate in the **20th TERRES DU GATINAIS CROSS-COUNTRY RALLY** must enter via the FFSA website (**see 3.1.1.11P**) or send the duly completed entry form to the rally secretariat, before **Monday, April 13 at midnight** (postmark as proof).

#### **3.1.1.9.P NUMBER OF ENTRIES**

The number of entries is limited to: **100** cars maximum

#### **3.1.1.10P ENTRY FEES**

The entry fees are set as follows::

- With optional organizer advertising: **€600**
- Without optional organizer advertising: **€1200**

Entry fees will be fully refunded in the following cases:

- Entry refused
- Roadbooks not collected (withdrawal declared in writing by email or mail)
- If the event does not take place

**The organizer will retain the entry fees from competitors who, after collecting their roadbook, do not appear at the start of the event, and from competitors who have not notified their**

**withdrawal in writing (email or mail) before administrative scrutineering.**

### **3.1.1.11P ENTRY FORM**

The entry form will only be accepted if accompanied by the payment of the entry fees (by cheque or bank transfer or on FFSA website/helloasso).

Cheques for payment of the entry fees should be made payable to: **ASA LOIRET**

**NB:** Any entry submitted by email will only be definitively accepted if confirmed by mail and accompanied by payment of the entry fees.

In the event of a waiting list, priority will be given to entries that are complete and accompanied by the entry fees. A bank account statement (RIB/IBAN) must be attached to the entry.

Any dispute concerning an entry (including cases where the entry fees are insufficiently funded or rejected by the bank) will be subject to a sanction request to the FFSA (in accordance with Article 3.10.1 of the International Sporting Code).

## **ARTICLE 4P. CARS AND EQUIPMENT**

*In accordance with the specific off-road rally rules and the technical regulations of FFSA and FIA off-road rallies*

### **4.3P. SERVICE**

In accordance with the specific off-road rally rules.

Assistance will be prohibited outside the sites provided for this purpose

Assistance teams are required to **CLEAN THE AREA OF ALL MUD TRACES** left after each intervention on the competition cars.

**ONLY ONE assistance vehicle per competition car** will be allowed in the service parks, with the "ASSISTANCE" sticker affixed to the top right of the windscreen.

A penalty of **€200** will be applied by the stewards for each violation of Article 4.3.P. Penalties are cumulative. The amount of the penalty will be retained by the organizer.

## **ARTICLE 5P. ADVERTISING**

### **5.1P. CAR IDENTIFICATION**

*In accordance with the Standard Rally Regulations and the French Off-Road Rally Championship.*

## 5.2P. ADVERTISING

Mandatory or optional advertising will be communicated by an **addendum** to these Supplementary Regulations.

The mandatory **AGORATT** advertising must be affixed to the FFSA position on the front plate of the vehicles and be visible, in accordance with Article 5.2 of the French Off-Road Rally Championship, under penalty of the sanctions provided for in Article 5.2.4 of the Standard Rally Regulations: a **€160** penalty for the first offense and a **€320** penalty in case of repetition.

## ARTICLE 6P. SITES AND FACILITIES

### 6.1P. DESCRIPTION

The **20th TERRES DU GATINAIS CROSS-COUNTRY RALLY** covers a total distance of **311,990 km**, of which **161,990 km** are liaison sections.

It is divided into **2** legs and **6** sections and includes **12** special stages with a total special stage distance of **150 km**.

The special stages are :

SS 1/3/5	LA SUCRERIE	12,8km
SS 2/4/6	C3M	12,4km
SS 7/9/11	PANNES	11,6km
SS 8/10/12	ST MAURICE	13,2km

The time schedule is shown in the "Itinerary" appendix.

### 6.2P. RECONNAISSANCES

*In accordance with the French Off-Road Rally Championship Regulations.*

Competitors are **required** to provide the registration numbers of reconnaissance motorcycles and quads and to wear the wristbands issued by the organization, as well as the stickers on the reconnaissance motorcycles/quads.

Failure to comply will result in the prohibition of reconnaissance, with penalties applied as provided in Article 6.2 of the FFSA Standard Rally Regulations.

#### 6.2.6P. DATES AND TIMES OF RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissances will take place on:

<b>Thursday april 23</b>	<b>from 8:30am to 6:30pm</b>
<b>Friday April 24</b>	<b>from 8:30am to 4:00pm</b>

A **reconnaissance booklet**, used to record the three authorized passages, will be issued to competitors. They must present it to the marshals.

Failure to submit the booklet for inspection will be penalized by a **1-minute penalty** during the first leg.

Reconnaissance must be carried out at **reduced speed**, as the roads are open to general traffic.

It is **forbidden to perform reconnaissance in the opposite direction.**

A convoy reconnaissance will take place if weather conditions allow:

On **Friday April 24 at 9:00am**

Start is at **sugar refinery truck park Corbeilles en Gâtinais**

Only 4 wheels drive admitted and tyres suitable for the weather conditions are **mandatory.**

Only driver and co-driver admitted

## **ARTICLE 7P. RUNNING OF THE RALLY**

*In accordance with the Standard Rally Regulations and the Specific Off-Road Rally Rules*

### **7.1.8.P ROADBOOKS**

The roadbooks will be distributed at the opening of the recce as well as the two bracelets for driver and co-driver with two stickers that must be affixed to the reconnaissance vehicles (motorcycles and quads only) according to the following dates and times:

**On Thursday april 23 from 8:30am to 6:30pm**

**On Friday April 24 from 8:30am to 4:00pm**

At Café de l'UNION 6 place Saint Germain Corbeilles en Gâtinais

**REMINDER: administrative checks will be carried out ONLY when the roadbooks are collected**

### **7.2P : GENERAL PROVISIONS REGARDING CHECKS**

#### **7.2.12P DISTINCTIVE SIGNS**

The distinctive signs of the marshals are:

- **Marshals:** vests and badges indicating their function.
- **Post Chiefs:** vests and badges indicating their function.
- **Technical Organizers:** vests and badges indicating their function.

#### **7.5.17.1P RETIREMENTS**

Any competitor retiring, whether on liaison sections or in a special stage, must **report their retirement as soon as possible** to the Rally HQ at the telephone number Indicated on the logbook

#### **7.5.17.3P RALLY ROUTE**

Competitors are informed that the apexes of corners and changes of direction, as well as the outer edges of chicanes, will be protected and marked to prevent exceeding the limits of the rally route.

Any contact with these markings or crossing them will be considered a **failure to respect the rally route.**

### **7.6P PARC FERMÉ**

In accordance with Article 7.6 of the Specific Off-Road Rally Rules, vehicles without a waterproof door (net) or SSV vehicles are **allowed to cover the car/vehicle with a tarpaulin** to protect it from possible adverse weather.

## ARTICLE 8P. PROTEST – APPEAL

In accordance with the FFSA General Prescriptions and the FFSA Standard Rally Regulations.

## ARTICLE 9P. CLASSIFICATIONS

In accordance with the French Off-Road Rally Championship Regulations.

## ARTICLE 10P. PRIZES – CUPS

### 10.1.1P. PRIZES

Prizes will be credited to the rights holders after the rally BY BANK TRANSFER. (It is imperative to send a bank account details for the transfer to the entries manager, see article 3.1.1.4P). PLEASE

NOTE that in the absence of the bank account details the prizes will not be distributed to the competitor.

**IMPORTANT: the finishing bonuses will be calculated according to the actual number of starters**

**In the event of cancellation or neutralisation of the stages, the performance bonuses of the stages concerned will not be awarded.**

### LEGEND GROUP

The organizer creates a special category called **LEGEND GROUP** outside the title recognized by the FFSA

These vehicles in groups T1A and T1B must meet the following criteria:

- chassis built before **2004** (date of creation of the technical passport)
- year of origin of the "manufacturer" reference of the engine before **2004**
- H-shaped or sequential gearbox depending on the vehicle's original equipment

- cantilevered or central motor depending on the original layout
- Free shock absorbers

The competitor must specify on the entry form his application in this category by committing to be technically compliant, which can be verified by the organizer

#### **10.1.2P. CUPS**

- **2 cups** for the first 3 classified in the French Championship (T1A/T3 combined)
- **2 cups** for the first 3 classified in the 4x4 Trophy (T2, T2B and T2B+ combined)
- **2 cups** for the first 3 classified in the 2WD Challenge (T1B)
- **2 cups** for the first 3 classified in the SSV Challenge (SSV)
- **2 trophies** for each other classified crew
- **2 cups** for marshals (2 beneficiaries drawn by lot)
- **2 cups** for 1<sup>st</sup> classified female crew

NB: cups not collected during the prize-giving ceremony will be forfeited if the crew is not duly represented.
